
Section III - INVENTORIES

The purpose of this section is to inventory landfill, incineration, recycling, composting facilities, and all activities used by the District during the reference year 2003. Open dump sites located in the District are also identified. The geographic locations of facilities within the District are shown on maps provided in Appendix E.

A. REFERENCE YEAR

In accordance with ORC 3734.56(A), the District has prepared its amended plan at least 15 months prior to the mandatory submittal date for the draft amended plan and established a reference year to be used for all subsequent projections in the plan. Ohio EPA has suggested that the reference year be the calendar year previous to the year in which the preparation of the amended plan begins. These requirements determine the following important dates:

1. Last date for submittal of the draft amended Plan to the Director, Ohio EPA: October 2005
2. Date by which the District should begin preparation of the amended Plan: July 2004
3. Reference Year: 2003

B. EXISTING SOLID WASTE LANDFILLS

Table III-1 presents information concerning the landfills used by the District for disposing of solid waste generated in the District.

Waste haulers permitted by the Mahoning County Board of Health used ten sanitary landfills, including landfills in three outlying solid waste districts to dispose of the District's generated solid waste. A map of the locations of the District's landfills can be found in Appendix E. Landfill information was collected from the *Ohio EPA 2003 Facility Data Report*, which is compiled from information submitted by the facility operators or owners to the Ohio EPA. Information regarding design capacity and remaining disposal capacity was also gathered from the *Ohio EPA 2003 Facility Data Report*.

C. EXISTING INCINERATORS AND RESOURCE RECOVERY FACILITIES

No resource recovery facilities existed within the District. Furthermore, during the reference year 2003, there were no known active incinerators still operating in the District. No incinerators received waste from the District during 2003. The incinerators in the District all ceased operations when the U.S. EPA and Ohio EPA adopted more stringent regulations for the permitting of air emissions.

However, a waste-to-energy (methane gas to electricity) pilot facility at the BFI Landfill was started in 2004. As this occurred after the reference year it is not presented on Table III-2.

D. EXISTING TRANSFER FACILITIES

Currently, there are no transfer facilities in the District. The Ohio EPA 2003 Facilities Data Report does not identify transfer facilities accepting Mahoning County waste. However, information contained in the document titled, "Annual District Report Review From Mahoning County SWMD," provides information on four (4) transfer facilities used by the District. These

figures have been incorporated into Table III-3. No transfer facilities located outside Ohio are used by the district; thus, Table III-7 will not be included for this report.

E. EXISTING RECYCLING ACTIVITIES

The District used a survey of recycling activities to collect information on the types and amounts of materials recycled, maximum daily capacity, actual quantity processed daily and the number of days per year in operation. A sample copy of the survey form is included in Appendix F.

A list of all the recycling facilities used by the District was developed with assistance from the Youngstown Litter Control Department and Youngstown State CERTT Program. Additionally, some facilities located in adjacent counties were identified from the private waste haulers survey. A supplementary source of information to develop the list was the *Directory of Ohio Recycling Centers Open to the Public*, prepared by the Division of Litter Prevention & Recycling, Ohio Department of Natural Resources. Locations of all recycling facilities within the boundary of the District are shown in Appendix E.

Table III-4 presents data on residential curbside recycling activities performed by the private sector throughout the District in 2003. Table III-5 presents a list of drop-off, buybacks / brokers and other recycling programs performed within the District. The “Recyclables Processed” from buybacks and brokers listed in Table III-5 are based on the 2003 surveys. These values reported by the buybacks and brokers in the 2003 surveys represent only the residential / commercial sector’s recycled materials. The percentage residential/commercial column is completed based on verbal interview. In this table, if no information was available for the reference year, the Recyclable Processed column was left blank. The industrial recycling tonnage is documented through the 2000 CERTT Program Industrial Surveys. The CERTT Program is defunct and detailed survey information was not available to assign industrial tonnage to specific brokers. The CERTT Program does not actually process materials. However, the tonnage of material tracked is shown in Table III-5 in the “Recyclable Processed” column. Similarly, the Materials Exchange Program provides a bulletin board service to facilitate reuse activities but does not process recyclable materials.

Drop-off Bin locations available in 2003 are provided in Table III-5. It should be noted that there are three (3) locations identified in Boardman Township. However, this is the result of a relocation of one of the bin sites. There were only total of two sites available at any given time in 2003. Therefore, these three (3) locations are only counted as two (2) sites.

The total tonnage of recyclable materials collected in 2003 were:

By the means the District has compiled these numbers for the ADR’s, double counting is essentially eliminated in the above table. Simply stated, the values listed under “other District Programs” in Table III-5 would result in double counting if they were to be included in the total as all of the programs’ recyclables are processed through other buyback brokers. All curbside recycling is processed out of district by Uni-Paper. Although some brokers do process ineligible materials as listed in the Table III-5, reporting procedures require buybacks and brokers to exclude

non-qualifying auto-bodies, rail cars, and demolition debris, as well as all industrial materials from their reported numbers. The district routinely performs follow-up to assure reported values are accurate. Therefore, these values only represent the eligible residential/commercial recycling.

F. EXISTING COMPOSTING/YARD WASTE MANAGEMENT FACILITIES

Table III-6 lists the composting/yard waste management facilities used by the District. In 2003, there were four publicly available active facilities. Of these four, only one, Boardman Township, reported receiving 16,500 tons for composting. There are four publicly available active facilities, three publicly available inactive facilities, seven captive active facilities, two captive inactive facilities, and seven not available active facilities.

G. EXISTING OPEN DUMPS AND WASTE TIRE DUMPS

A total of 60 open dumpsites were found, all of which were waste tire dumpsites. A list of all the dumpsites was compiled with the assistance of the Solid Waste Program at the Mahoning County General Health District, and the Ohio EPA Division of Solid Waste Management. Each site is identified on Table III-8. Most sites are located within the municipal boundaries of the City of Youngstown. Small indiscriminate littering and dumping occurs in all communities. Such sporadic sites are not recorded.

Ohio Revised Code Section 1502.05, the Ohio Litter Control Law, authorizes the Ohio Department of Natural Resources to award grants to local governments and state agencies for litter prevention activities. Comprehensive Litter Prevention Grants are available in varying amounts to communities interested in conducting community based litter prevention programs. Eligible activities include litter collection, litter law enforcement, education and awareness activities, Keep America Beautiful participation and others. Special Project Grants are designed for small communities to implement litter prevention and recycling activities to address local concerns. Funds from comprehensive and special project grants have been used to clean up illegal dumpsites within the District.

Local governments within the boundaries of the District have received various state grants and awards for litter prevention programs. The Mahoning County Commissioners have been awarded comprehensive grants from 1984 to 2005. The Cities of Youngstown and Struthers also received comprehensive grants during various years within this period.

H. ASH, FOUNDRY SAND AND SLAG DISPOSAL SITES

The District does not have any licensed or unlicensed facilities for the disposal of fly ash, foundry sand or slag within its boundary; therefore, Table III-9 will not be completed for this report.

I. MAP OF FACILITIES AND SITES

Using the symbols provided in the District Solid Waste Plan Format, the location of each facility and disposal site listed in III.B through III.H is shown on a map of Mahoning County. These maps can be found in Appendix E.

This map is to be submitted to the Ohio EPA only.

J. EXISTING COLLECTION SYSTEMS - HAULERS

To determine the manner and extent of solid waste collection within District, a survey of private waste haulers was conducted in the summer of 2004. A copy of the survey form is included in Appendix F. Questionnaires were mailed to 167 solid waste haulers listed by the Mahoning County General Health District. Additionally, completion of a questionnaire is requested by Mahoning Co. General Health District to grant licensure to haulers. Data from the licensing files was also used. The questionnaires solicited information on collection routes, disposal sites, utilization of transfer stations, recycling activities and quantities of residential, commercial or industrial waste.

Most residential and commercial waste collection services are provided on an individual subscription basis. Businesses, industries and residents make arrangements with private haulers for solid waste pick up and disposal. The City of Youngstown contracts with private waste haulers to remove solid waste from city residences. The City of Struthers and the City of Campbell also have contracts with private haulers to provide waste removal. The remaining townships and municipalities do not provide such a service for their residents.

While solid waste collection services were provided by a multitude of haulers in the larger communities, single haulers primarily served some smaller townships. For example, competing haulers served Austintown, Boardman and Poland Townships, the Villages of Lowellville and Poland. Waste Management, Inc. provided collection services for Youngstown. Small haulers mainly serviced Berlin, Ellsworth, Coitsville and Canfield Townships. Each of these haulers serve one township.

Table III-10 provides the information about the existing haulers in the District.
